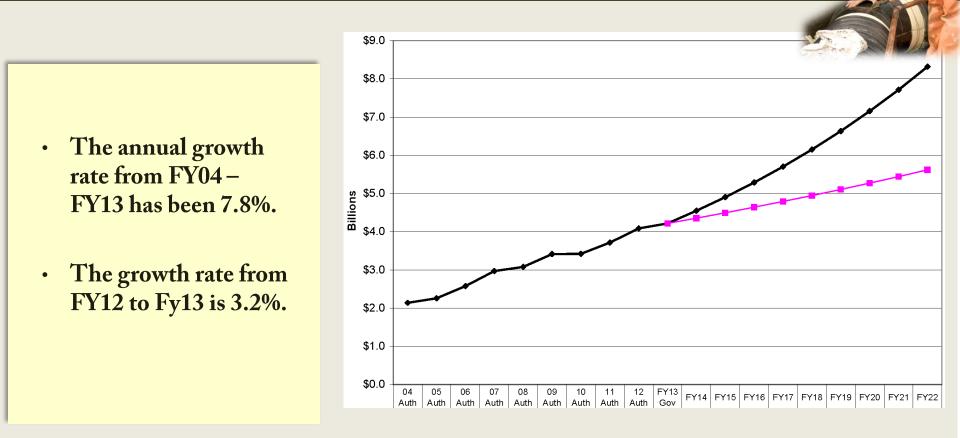

Growth in Alaska's General Fund (UGF) Budget for Agency Operations

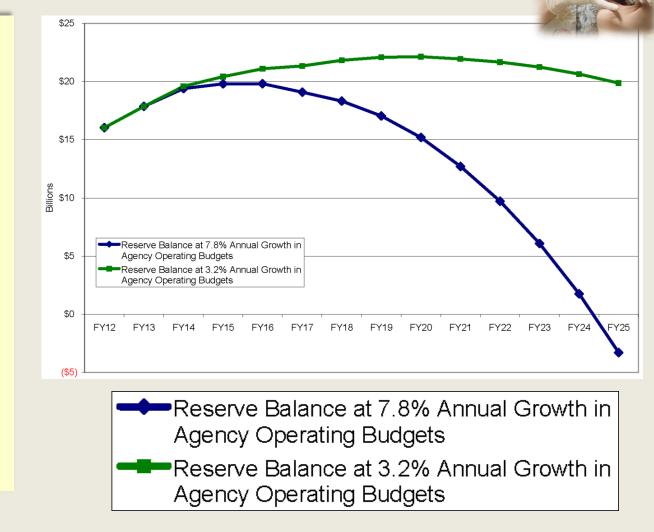

Projected Reserve Balances

(Assumes revenue of \$7 billion annually after FY21 and a constant (\$882 million/year) capital budget)

Changing the agency operations growth rate from 7.8% to 3.2% has a significant impact on the projected life of the reserves; the change results in a difference of nearly \$24 billion in FY25 reserve balances.

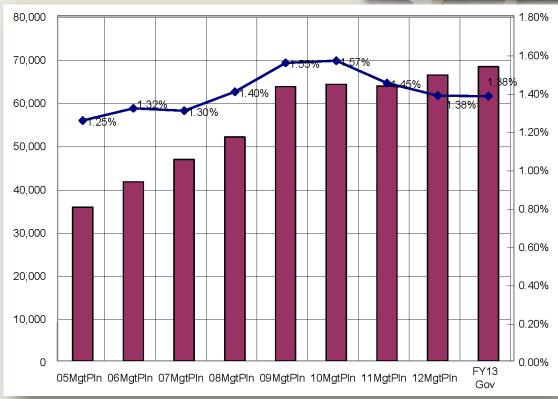


Share of Total Agency Operations

- The department's GF budget grew by \$32.5 million between FY05 and the FY13 Governor's Request – an average annual growth rate of 8.4%.
- Growth since FY09 has been \$4.6 million (1.8% growth rate).
- The department has experienced moderate growth over the past eight fiscal years and continues to represent a small portion of the overall statewide budget.

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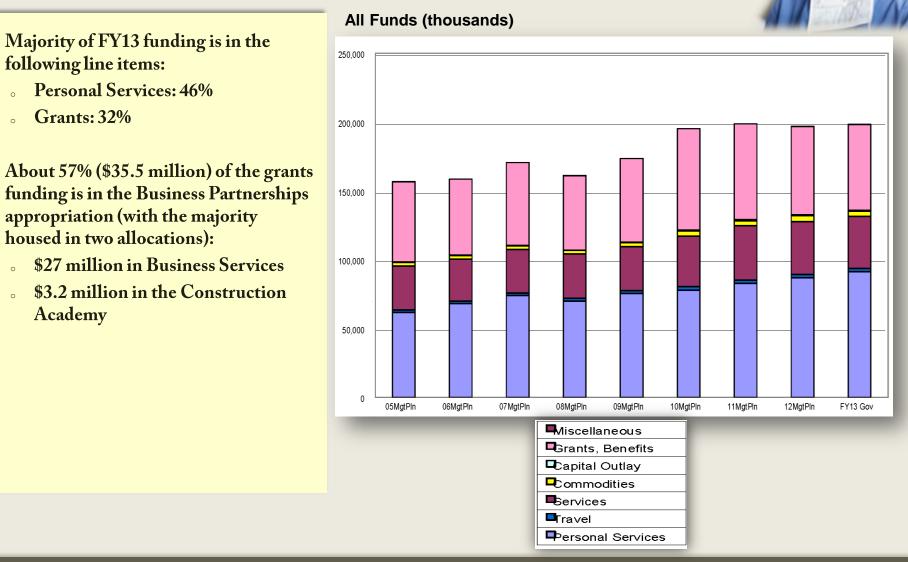
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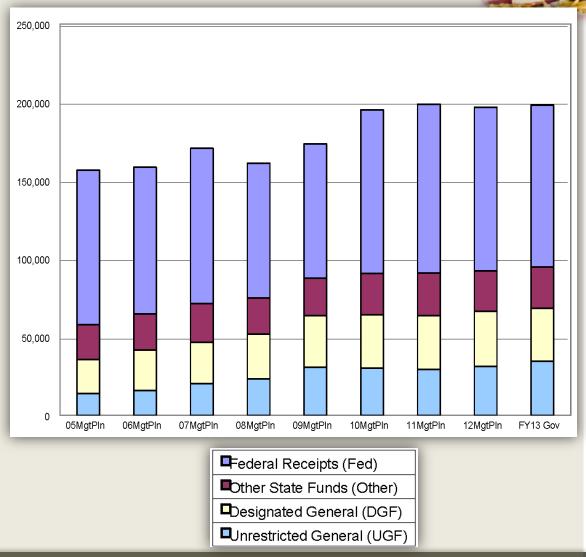


Total Funding Comparison by Fund Group

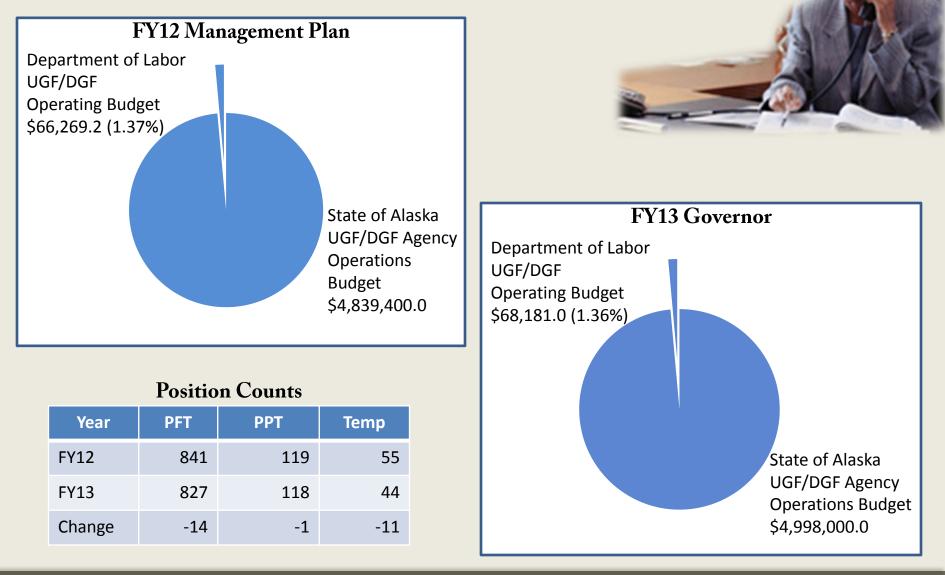
All Funds (thousands)

• Between FY05 & FY13:

- UGF increased by \$20.6 million (149.7%)
- DGF increased by \$11.9 million (54.4%)
- Other funds increased by \$4.2 million (18.7%)
- Federal Funds increased by \$4.9 million (5%)

FY13 Governor's Budget Overview

- Workers Safety and Compensation Administration Account (WSCAA)
 - \$2,000.0 UGF for ongoing operating expenses within Occupational Safety and Health that are no longer supportable with WSCAA
- AVTEC
 - **\$250.0 UGF for increasing operating expenses at AVTEC**
 - \$226.8 UGF, \$100.0 DGF to support a registered nurse program
- Division of Vocational Rehabilitation
 - \$100.0 UGF for Project SEARCH
 - ^o \$200.0 UGF to strengthen the Independent Living network in Alaska
- Workers' Compensation Benefits Guaranty Fund
 - \$103.2 DGF to support a collections officer
 - \$220.0 DGF benefit payment authorization
