Budget Results:

FY13 State Operating Budget: The RN program was funded for three years. We received a one-time \$200,000 budget increase (we had asked for \$250,000) for next year. In addition, we did receive the \$250,000 supplemental for this current fiscal year (FY12).

FY13 Capital Budget: The 3rd Ave. Dorm Replacement was funded at \$16,075,000. The existing 3rd Ave. dorm is in very poor condition and a hard sell for attracting Alaska's best and brightest. We received \$1,000,000 for deferred maintenance which will allow us to continue to keep our aging facilities safe and serviceable for years to come. A welcomed addition to the capital budget was \$39,000 for the maritime simulator to add some capabilities requested by the Marine Pilots.

FY12 Instructional Programs:

Enrollment: 425 long term; 850 short term (less than 8 weeks) students

Graduation: 89% (FY11) Placement: 94% (FY11)

Industrial electrical Expansion - Completed

Additional space to allow for Wind Training

Demolition of the old culinary building – In Progress - June completion date.

Cafeteria, Bakery, Dish room Remodel - Starting
