- First you will have to get a TWIC credential by going to this website:

- 2. You will have to get a special physical exam. Have your doctor fill out this exact form: http://www.uscg.mil/nmc/forms/medical/CG719KE.pdf
- 3. Get & pass a "DOT 5 Panel" or a "SAMHSA 5 Panel" drug test. Keep the results!
- Fill out this application for a Merchant Mariner Credential (MMC): http://www.uscg.mil/forms/cg/CG_719B.pdf
 (If you have trouble with your MMC application call 1-888-427-5662)
- Pay the MMC processing & issuance fee at <u>www.pay.gov</u> print and keep your receipt.
