Suggested presentation contents:

- 1. Description of current training and /or services provided
- 2. Description of partnerships with private industry or other education or training providers give examples of collaboration with partners and industry based advisory boards/councils
- 3. Examples of successes and challenges in responding to private industry workforce needs
- 4. What are the outcomes of your training programs/services? How many students enroll in your program, how many complete/graduate from your program, and how many attain employment? What credentials, certificates, licenses, etc. do the students earn?
- 5. Do you follow up with your graduates to determine the success of the program? If so, what input are you receiving from your graduates as to the impact the program had on the graduates attaining employment?
- 6. How do you determine which programs to offer? For example, industry advisory council; alignment with state workforce development plans; state, regional, or local labor market information; other?
- 7. If your program is a secondary program, are your graduates going to postsecondary training and attaining a career?
- 8. Funding questions:
 - i. How is your entity/program funded?
 - ii. What are the sources and length of funding?
 - iii. How might changes in Federal and State funding sources impact the future of your entity/program?
 - iv. What are your predictions of funding your entity/program in the future?
- 9. What may the State of Alaska and other organizations do to assist you?
