

RESOLUTION NO. 00-02
A RESOLUTION ON PERFORMANCE LEVELS FOR TRAINING
PROGRAMS UNDER ALASKA HUMAN RESOURCE
INVESTMENT COUNCIL OVERSIGHT

WHEREAS, the Alaska Human Resource Investment Council is a public organization which is accountable through its council members and staff to the citizens, the Legislature and the Governor of Alaska; and

WHEREAS, the Legislature passed Senate Bill 334 (Chapter 085 SLA 1998), and

WHEREAS, Governor Tony Knowles signed SB 334 into law, and

WHEREAS, the legislation requires the Alaska Human Resource Investment Council to adopt standards for the evaluation of employment-related education training programs operated by the state listed under AS 23.15.580(f), and

WHEREAS, the Workforce Investment Act of 1998 also requires that performance standards be set for training and vocational education programs that receive federal funds, and

WHEREAS, the Council's Evaluation & Assessment Committee is charged with establishing program standards based on data collected for these programs over a three-year period, and

WHEREAS, SB 334 requires the AHRIC to report on program performance based on these standards,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that:

The Alaska Human Resource Investment Council adopts the program performance standards brought before it today and directs council staff to work with the program administrators to report program performance pursuant to Chapter 085 SLA 1998.
