RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE MODIFICATION OF THE ALASKA STRATEGIC
TWO-YEAR STATE PLAN FOR TITLE 1 OF THE WORKFORCE INVESTMENT ACT OF
1998 AND THE WAGNER-PEYSER ACT

WHEREAS, the Alaska Workforce Investment Board is a private industry driven public organization that is accountable through its members including representatives from business and industry, education, and organized labor to the residents, the Legislature and the Governor of Alaska;

WHEREAS, the Alaska Workforce Investment Board shall act as the lead state planning and coordinating entity for state human resource programs involving employment training, vocational education, and workforce development;

WHEREAS, the Alaska Department of Labor and Workforce Development is responsible for submitting the Modification of the Alaska Strategic Two Year State Plan for Title 1 of the Workforce Investment Act of 1998 and the Wagner-Peyser Act as required by the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 to the U.S. Department of Labor for approval;

WHEREAS, the Alaska Department of Labor and Workforce Development requests review and comment from the Alaska Workforce Investment Board for the modification of the Alaska Strategic Two Year State Plan for Title 1 of the Workforce Investment Act of 1998 and the Wagner-Peyser Act;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska Workforce Investment Board officially requests the Modification of the Alaska Strategic Two Year State Plan for Title 1 of the Workforce Investment Act of 1998 and the Wagner-Peyser Act be forwarded to the Alaska Department of Labor and Workforce Development for the purpose of publishing and solicitation of public comments and the governor for final approval.
