A full budget implementation of the grants unit transfer to AWIB. Currently in legislation, SB66/HB 68, which is to combine Workers' Compensation and Labor Standards and Safety divisions into one Division of Worker's Safety and Compensation, and the reauthorization of TVEP distributions.
